As a member of the CBCSA you are an important part of the South Australian children's literature community working towards our Branch objectives of

- engaging the South Australian community with literature for young Australians
- encouraging children's reading through a variety of community based activities;
- and supporting South Australian authors, illustrators and publishers, and those who provide children's literature services in schools and the community.

You do this through funds from your membership fee, through your participation in CBCSA events and projects, and also through your promotion of CBCSA objectives and activities to your personal contacts and through social media (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter etc.).

- Access feeds on Instagram and Twitter

Corporate 2 Larger businesses, larger schools, larger public libraries <i>* self-determined by member</i>	\$75	- Three guests at members' rates to CBCSA events - Two free email outs to members under CBCSA branded logo, or two larger visual ads in newsletter p.a. (<i>Copy provided by member</i>) - Can buy additional ads or mail-outs to members at \$50 per time - Cross promotion by CBCSA on social media (if requested and meeting Branch objectives) - May be listed on SA Greats page if a recognized relevant SA business or agency, under page criteria
